


Dear Reader,

During this month of June, our two communities were happily reunited in Brooksville, Florida. The Sisters who were stationed in Phoenix returned to Brooksville at the completion of their academic year. After a few days of recreation, we are now ready to take up the summer duties. Most of the Sisters will spend the upcoming weeks of June, July, and August in preparing for the next school year. The summertime, for the congregation, is a brief but precious opportunity for further training in the teaching apostolate. The Sisters will take courses in the Classics: literature, Latin, and philosophy, and some will apply themselves to musical study.

Once August sets in, this brief training period will end, the duty as "student" will evolve into that of "teacher" once again, and August's final weeks will be used for immediate school preparation: course syllabi, lesson plans, classroom setup, etc... It will be during these final weeks of August that three of our Sisters will fly back across the United States, not to Phoenix, but to Modesto, California. There, they will help Father Palma begin a school for Catholic families in the area. These families have long been asking for a school run by Sisters; and, until the present, we have not been able to carry out that request.

Besides the starting of this new school in September, we also hope to put another teaching plan into effect. Online teaching has long been in use by educators around the world; and, next year, we hope to utilize this technology. Since a few families have expressed interest in
